


A retelling of The Great Gatsby by F. Scott Fitzgerald


A retelling of The Tempest by William Shakespeare


Inspired by the fairy tale "Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs"


Inspired by the folktales in Tales of the Arabian Nights


Based on the fairy tale


Based on Hamlet by William Shakespeare
