**MY SISTER'S KEEPER by Jodi Picoult** Thirteen-year-old Anna, conceived specifically to provide blood and bone marrow for her sister Kate, who was diagnosed with a rare form of leukemia at the age of two, decides to sue her parents for control of her body when her mother wants her to donate a kidney to Kate.

**THE ADORATION OF JENNA FOX by Mary E. Pearson** In the not-too-distant future, when biotechnological advances have made synthetic bodies and brains possible but illegal, a seventeen-year-old girl, recovering from a serious accident and suffering from memory lapses, learns a startling secret about her existence.

**DOUBLE HELIX by Nancy Werlin** Eighteen-year-old Eli discovers a shocking secret about his life and his family while working for a Nobel Prize-winning scientist whose specialty is genetic engineering.

**DR. FRANKLIN'S ISLAND by Ann Halam** When their plane crashes over the Pacific Ocean, three science students are left stranded on a tropical island and then imprisoned by a doctor who is performing horrifying experiments on humans involving the transfer of animal genes.

**THE BOY WHO COULDN'T DIE by William Sleator** When his best friend dies in a plane crash, sixteen-year-old Ken has a ritual performed that will make him invulnerable, but soon learns that he had good reason to be suspicious of the woman he paid to lock his soul away.

**WITHER by Lauren DeStafano** After modern science turns every human into a genetic time bomb with men dying at age twenty-five and women dying at age twenty, girls are kidnapped and married off in order to repopulate the world. *The first book in a trilogy.*

**UNWIND by Neal Shusterman** Three teens embark upon a cross-country journey in order to escape from a society that salvages body parts from children ages thirteen to eighteen. *The first book in a series.*
